The smallest dolphins are Maui's Dolphin which measure at 4 feet long and 90 pounds in weight. Bottlenose dolphins measure at 6 feet long and 300 pounds.



Otter Facts:

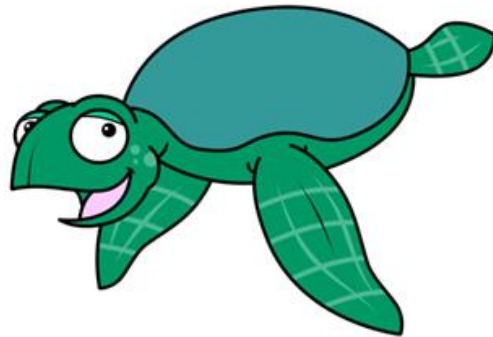
Otter species range in size from the smallest measure at 2 feet in length and weigh about 2 pounds. The largest otter species can measure at 6 feet and weigh up to 100 pounds!



Octopus Facts:

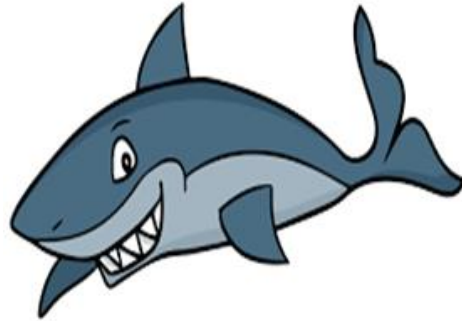
Octopuses can reach speeds up to 25 miles per hour!

Regular octopuses live about 18 months. Giant octopuses live 48 months.



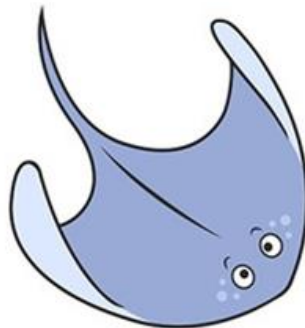
Sea Turtle Facts:

When sea turtles are born they measure only 5 centimeters long in length! They grow up to 150 centimeters in length! Sea turtles can live up to 50 years, sometimes 80 years!



Shark Facts:

The smallest shark is only 1 foot in length and the largest shark can measure up to 50 feet in length. Sharks live in between 12 years and 15 years of age.



Stingray Facts: Stingrays can live in between 15 years of age and 25 years of age. The smallest stingray is 10cm across and weighs about 400g. The oceanic manta ray is the largest ray reaching up to 700cm in wing span and weighs 2,000kg.
